water-efficient products, such as modern dishwashers can make a real difference. Plus replace old lightbulbs for more efficient LED ones.

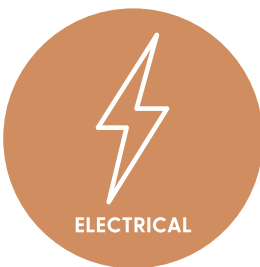
To cut carbon emissions, why not try riding a bike or walking when possible or taking public transport.

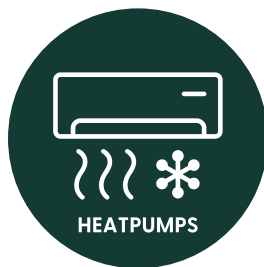
Some families are choosing to downsize into tiny homes, embracing a simpler lifestyle with less clutter and more time for what really matters.

Reusing, recycling, and repairing are also on the rise. Donating clothes, curtains, and other items to charity shops extends the life of products and reduces demand for added resources.

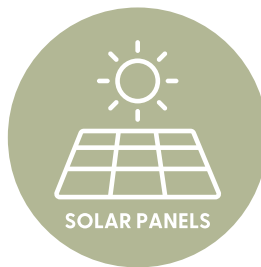

Be very clear about what you want and seek the advice and guidance of your builder or tradesperson who often can suggest alternatives. Be very specific about your requirements so that you will receive an accurate quote and minimise the chance for misunderstandings.

Agree to the job in writing: what is to be done, how long it will take, labour and materials to be used for the job and the final cost including GST.

Consumers can have confidence in engaging a builder that is a member of New Zealand Certified Builders Association (NZCB). In order to be eligible for membership builders must be trade qualified. Trade-

qualification means that a builder or tradesperson has robust minimum standards of training and skill.



Registered Master Joiners provide full consultation and design services for all joinery needs and work closely with other design professionals to ensure that the finished product looks and functions at its best.

There are plenty of smaller jobs that need doing by experts from time to time that might not necessarily need a master tradesperson to complete. 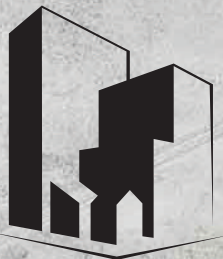

Finding yourself an electrician

If you are moving to a new area, you may need to find new tradespeople.

What should you look for when hiring an electrician?

It is important to ensure they're qualified, dependable, and a good fit for your specific job.

Ensure they are certified and registered to perform electrical work in your region.

Make sure they have public liability insurance in case something goes wrong.

Choose someone with experience in the type of work you need (e.g., rewiring, installing lighting, switchboard upgrades).

It is a good idea to ask for past client reviews or photos of previous work.

A good electrician can offer

practical solutions and advice.

They should be able to give you a detailed quote upfront. Ask if they charge hourly or per job and confirm any extra costs.

Communication with any contractor is important. Are they polite, punctual, and easy to talk to? Do they return your calls or emails promptly?

You should feel confident they understand the job and can explain it to you.

They should work to national safety standards.

And on a final note, a good tradesperson leaves the job site safe and clean.

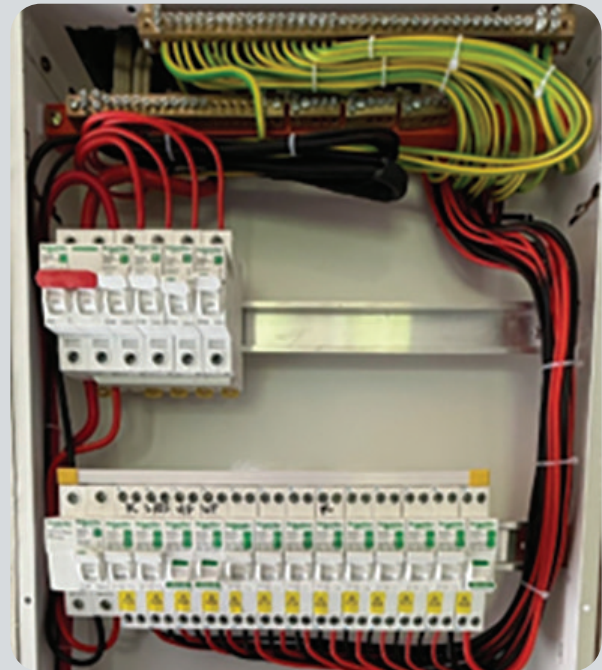

Safety is No1

This gives you peace of mind that your job will be done professionally and if any concerns, you have recourse through official channels.

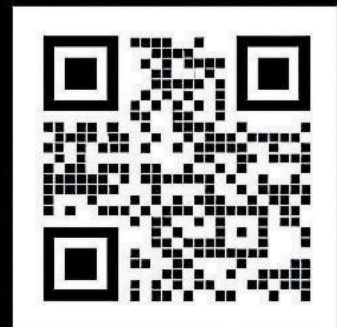

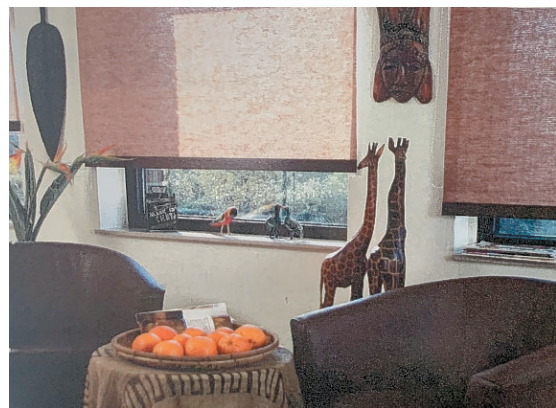

Plumbing-a job for the experts

Restricted work

Whether you have a squeak or a leak, when your plumbing goes wrong, having a qualified, authorised, tradesman on hand to fix the problem is such a huge relief.

In New Zealand, most sanitary plumbing, gas fitting or drain laying is 'restricted'. That means it's illegal to do it yourself because of the health and safety risks. You also risk expensive mistakes and even voiding your insurance.

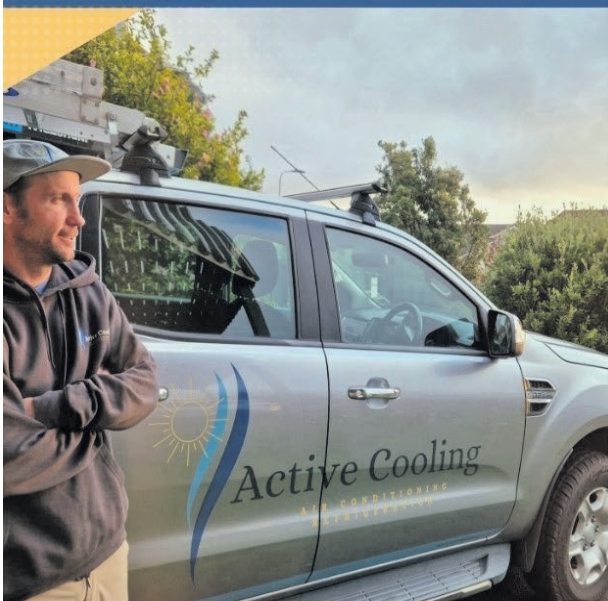

PLUMBING

It always pays to check your plumber, gasfitter or drainlayer is licensed to do the work

Before you begin renovating or doing work on your home or business, there's a lot to decide before you get started.

All work conducted at your property must meet the requirements of the Building Code, regardless of whether it requires a code of compliance certificate or not. You almost might need to notify your insurance company of renovations to keep within your policy.

For any plumbing, gas fitting or drain laying work, make sure the person undertaking the work is licensed to do so.

The Plumbers, Gasfitters and Drainlayer's Board recommends before using the services of a licensed tradesperson:

1. Shop around and obtain a range of written quotes before you decide.
2. Ask to see a tradesperson's New Zealand Practising Licence and check the expiry date to see that it is current.
3. A plumber, gasfitter or drainlayer can produce their licence via an app on their phone or a physical licence.
4. When checking a tradesperson's licence, also ensure that they are licensed to conduct that particular work. For example, if they are conducting plumbing work, it is good to check that they are licensed to conduct plumbing work. The same applies for gasfitting and drainlaying.
5. Ask the tradesperson whether they require any supervision and who their supervisor is. You can check the name of the supervisor on the public register to ensure that they are also licensed.
6. Search the licence number of your chosen registered tradesperson on the public register at www.pgdb.co.nz

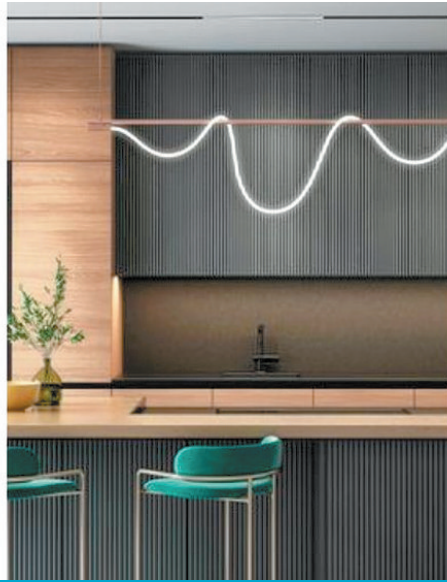

GLAZING

Having double glazing in your home can have an influence on both your health, and your comfort.

Double glazing is a window with two panes of glass separated by a layer of insulating gas. It is like having a cushion of insulation between the two panes. The chilly air cannot reach the interior pane of glass meaning it prevents condensation forming. This construction provides such benefits as reduced noise control, reduced condensation, as well as reduced heat transfer, which results in better energy efficiency and lower power bills.



Having double glazed windows can reduce your heat loss or gain by up to 30%, (some companies advertise this percentage way higher) compared to single glazed windows. This is noticeable in both winter and summer. You will find you lose other heat through the walls, floor, roof, and air escaping. Double glazing in new homes became compulsory in late 2007 with the aim to increase the thermal resistance (insulation) performance requirements for housing and to facilitate efficient use of energy. Double glazing will reduce damage done by the UV rays and

will reduce moisture created by condensation that forms on single glazed windows plus these windows are much harder to break than single glazed windows, making it harder for people to break into your home. Laminated or toughened glass will add another layer of security to your double-glazed windows.

Some homeowners take the plunge and double glaze either all or some of their single glazed windows. If you cannot afford to replace all your windows, why not

consider the windows on the south side. You will be amazed by the difference it will make to that cold bedroom or bathroom.

Installation

Due to its complexity, double glazing requires professional installation. The process involves removing existing windows and replacing them with double-glazed units. If your new windows are not exposed to the weather they should last 25-30 years and one that is exposed to the weather should give you 20 years.
